



Pre Kindergarten at Red Bell

Our Pre Kindergarten program is a 3 or 5 day a week program which runs from 8:45am -11:30am. We offer before care and after care. Students in Kindergarten are expected to learn to read, perform basic math functions, master handwriting, listen attentively for long periods of time and function with ever increasing levels of expectations. Our PreK program is designed to prepare your child for Kindergarten.

Curriculum for our PreK program has been developed from the Michigan Department of Education standards to ensure a successful transition into Kindergarten. Our Lead teacher has a bachelors degree in Early Childhood Education. Our program uses developmentally appropriate, hands-on learning centers to build enthusiasm for school and confidence to solve problems while interacting with peers. Through interactive teaching experiences and active discovery, children participate in Language and Literacy, Social Studies, Social/Emotional Development, Gross/Fine Motor Development, Mathematics, Science, Technology, and Art. In our classroom your child will learn the 25 Pre-Primer sight words, letter sounds, continue their handwriting development with our Handwriting without Tears curriculum, learn early math skills through our Every Day Math curriculum, participate in science experiments, and keep a journal.
