

Primer Preschool Goals

Emotional Goals

- Displays a sense of security
- Exhibits self-confidence
- Is willing to try something new

Self-Help Goals

- Takes care of own toileting needs without coaching from an adult.
- Cleans up after self at snack, lunch
- Participates in classroom clean-up

Behavioral Goals

- Listens attentively for a 10 minute group time
- Follows directions
- Exhibits self-control
- Uses toys and materials appropriately

Social Goals

- Interacts positively with adults/Peers
- Stands up for own rights
- Learn to resolves conflicts peacefully
- Exhibits good manners; courteous

Language Goals

- Has age-appropriate vocabulary
- Expresses needs and ideas verbally
- Recites jingles and rhymes
- Follows 3-step verbal directions

Physical Goals (Small Muscle)

- Beginning pencil grasp
- Begin to fringe with scissors
- Begin to make marks on paper/name writing

Cognitive Goals

- Demonstrates knowledge of colors/shapes
- Demonstrates a willingness to learn
- Demonstrates knowledge of numbers/letters
